

Strong growth in revenue in the first half of 2008

Norbert Dentressangle Group posted sustained growth for both of its businesses, Transport and Logistics, boasting mid-year revenue of EUR 1.6 billion. With the acquisition of Christian Salvesen Group on December 14th 2007, consolidated revenue for the first half of the year rose by 83% as against the first half of 2007. Like-for-like, growth came out at 86%. The Logistics business accounted for 42% of total revenue, more than doubling its H1 2007 volume.

Organic business growth over the first half of the year was extremely consistent throughout the Group at 7.4% for the historical scope and 6.7% for the Christian Salvesen scope on a like-for-like basis. The Group's H1 performance once again reflects the strength of its positioning on the European transport and logistics market and the successful integration of Christian Salvesen. Norbert Dentressangle Group's operational and reporting procedures have been harmonised throughout the scope, which is now referred to as the Norbert Dentressangle brand.

A new Chief Executive Officer

At its meeting on July 24th 2008, the Supervisory Board of Norbert Dentressangle Group appointed François Bertreau Chief Executive Officer to replace Jean-Claude Michel, as proposed by its Chairman, Norbert Dentressangle.

Following the acquisition and integration of Christian Salvesen, the Supervisory Board considered that a change was necessary in order to guide the Group through this new and very important phase in its history with success and prepare it to face the forthcoming challenges with a view to global development.

François Bertreau remains with the general management of the Logistics Division to oversee strategy, acquisitions and communication. The Executive Board's close-knit members include Hervé Montjotin, Executive Vice President, who couples the general management of the Transport Division with human resources and purchasing responsibilities at the Group level, and Patrick Bataillard, Chief Financial Officer.

In his comments on the figures for the first half of 2008 and on the Group's outlook, François Bertreau reaffirmed his confidence in the Group to reach its announced targets, despite a more challenging market, which include organic business growth of 6% to 8% like-for-like based on 2007 proforma revenue (EUR 3.08 billion) and growth in recurring operating income as against the 2007 proforma figure.
